

ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be: Winnepesaukee Family Alliance For Boating Safety. (WinnFABS)

ARTICLE II

The Corporation is organized exclusively for the promotion of the common good and general welfare of the citizens of the Lake Winnepesaukee region of the State of New Hampshire within the meaning of Section 501(c)(4) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended, or any successor provision of federal tax law (the "Code"); provided, however, that in promoting social welfare, the Corporation shall (1) not directly or indirectly participate or intervene in political campaigns on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, (2) not conduct its activities primarily for the purpose of operating a social club within the meaning of Section 501(c)(7) of the Code and (3) not carry on a business with the general public in a manner similar to organizations which are operated for profit.

Within the aforesaid purposes, the objects of the Corporation may include (but shall not be limited to) the following:

- A. To educate the public on boating safety.
- B. To develop and or advocate legislation that provides for boating safety, including a speed limit on Lake Winnepesaukee.
- C. To engage, subject to the provisions of Article VII, below, in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under RSA Chapter 292.
